IMPORT CONDITIONS FOR BEE PRODUCTS FROM NEW ZEALAND (OCTOBER 2023)

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Permits to import are for a single consignment only
- Each consignment must be accompanied by an Export Health Certificate issued by the Competent Authority
 of New Zealand for the import of bee products.
- The Export Health Certificate must include as follows: exporter details, certificate number, Name of Competent Authority, importer details, country of origin, any transit country (if applicable), port of loading, means of transport, port of discharge, container identification, official seal identification, processing establishment details, number of packages, net weight (kg).
- The Export Health Certificate must include the following attestations by an Official Veterinarian:

Products:

- > were produced by the honey bee (Apis mellifera) and were derived from plants;
- were processed in accordance with New Zealand regulatory requirements for items intended for human consumption;
- > were harvested from apiaries within New Zealand
- have been found free from spore forms of P.larvae by a test method described in the relevant chapter of the most recent version of the WOAH Terrestrial Manual
